The 2010 Dublin Charity Cup is just a short time away. The Tournament Committee and the City of Dublin are looking forward to hosting players, coaches, and parents of the over 200 teams from the Midwest and Canada. We are looking forward to a weekend of fun and excitement, which will result in a substantial donation to **Big Brothers Big Sisters Association of Central Ohio**.

**Team registration** will be held this year at our host hotel, the **Columbus Marriott Northwest, 5605 Blazer Pkwy., Dublin, OH, 43017**, 614-791-1000, on **Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 5 PM to 9 PM**. Only one team representative is required. *Your game is subject to forfeiture if you miss Friday registration and can not comply with requirements Saturday morning. Please be prepared to present at registration (you may also pre-register by mail at least 10-days ahead of time for our review):*

1. A copy (not the original) of your **team's certified roster** for us to keep throughout the tournament.
2. A **Combined Liability/Medical Release** form (white) signed by an adult for each participant is preferred. A USYSA Player Membership Form (white copy) for the current year with both medical treatment and liability sections completed with proper signature authorizations is acceptable in lieu of the release form.
3. If using guest players, a **guest player roster**, properly authorized, along with their photo player pass. Signature authorizations should also appear on the Combined Release in #2 above.
4. A **travel permit**, for teams outside of Ohio South (including Ohio North). US Club teams should provide a "Letter of Good Standing" (Registration Forms #CO11) in lieu of a travel permit (available at [www.usclubsoccer.org](http://www.usclubsoccer.org)).
5. **Player passes with photo required for all participants (including guest players)**. Player passes will be cross-checked against the certified roster, Membership Forms and Liability/Medical Release form. Player passes will be returned to the team representative. They must be presented to the referee at each game.
