Dublin Soccer League Statement – 2009/2010 season

Since 2007, the Dublin Soccer League (DSL) has supported three organizations providing higher level soccer services to the City of Dublin; Team Ohio F.C., Ohio Premier and Dublin Middle Tier Soccer Organization (DMTSO).

As further clarification regarding these organizations;

- DSL considers Ohio Premier Girls' Soccer Club of Dublin, Ohio, OP/Eagles and Ohio Football Club (OFC) to be the same organization and will be collectively referred to as OP
- DMTSO has recently passed a measure at their board to utilize the name Dublin United as a DBA for Dublin Middle Tier Soccer Organization. DSL considers DMTSO and Dublin United to be the same organization.
- The structure and content of Team Ohio FC has not changed since 2007

Each of these three organizations (OP, DMTSO, Team Ohio) is currently represented on the Board of Directors of DSL with voting rights.

At the present time, DSL will support these three organizations for the 2009/2010 seasons. This support includes declaration of teams to the league, scheduling of field usage and accommodations at Avery and Darree for home games.

At a DSL board meeting held April 2, 2009, the board reviewed a field capacity analysis for Avery and Darree fields. The analysis for the 2008/2009 seasons showed that we are at or above capacity for non-general recreation games scheduled on these fields. Due to the recent expansion of the OP/Eagles and Team Ohio organizations, the DSL board unanimously approved a measure capping the number of teams to be fielded by each of the club organizations, not to exceed the same levels from the 2008/2009 seasons. Exceptions to this cap will be made for teams with primarily Dublin residents or School District residents (Primarily = 100% minus one resident player.)
