Spring season begins April 5th

- ◆ The Dublin Soccer League spring season runs from April 5th through May 17th. Our arrangement with the City of Dublin provides for use of Avery Park and Darree Fields beginning in April. This allows time for maximum grass growth to protect the fields from damage due to excessive use. As with last year, our seven week spring season starts on the Saturday at the conclusion of spring break and finishes prior to the Memorial Day holiday weekend.
- ◆ Coaches will begin contacting players just after March 15th for spring season. If you have not heard from your child's coach by March 31st, contact the office. Also, please keep the coach informed of any planned absences.



St. Patrick's Day Parade

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q.** Is my child registered for spring?
A. Children who were registered only for fall 2002 were sent a postcard (in November) with information on spring fees and deadlines.
- Q.** When will I hear from the coach?
A. Mid to late March.
- Q.** What is my child's game schedule?
A. Check on our website in mid march for team schedules.
- Q.** It's game day and the weather is bad, what should I do?
A. Show up at the fields at your game time unless the website indicates all games have been cancelled or you've received a call from your coach.
- Q.** Where do I park for games at Avery?
A. In designated parking areas only in the north or south lots—not on the grass or on the curve (your car could be ticketed or towed).
